The Synopsis Outreach Foundation's **Green + 1 Challenge:**  
\$2,000 Grants for Green Projects Available to CA Teachers

The non-profit Synopsis Outreach Foundation is awarding \$2,000 grants to help 10 California teachers develop and lead class or school-wide projects that have a positive and measurable impact on the environment. The application deadline for the Synopsis Outreach Foundation's **Green + 1 Challenge** is April 16, 2012 for projects to be implemented during the 2012-'13 school year.

Submitted project proposals will be reviewed by a distinguished panel of environmentalists and judged on their practicality and the measurability of their impact. Schools chosen to receive a **Green + 1 Challenge** grant will be notified in May 2012.
